In our letter dated June 28, 2006 we listed the Self-insurance assessment rates as an informational only item. Unfortunately, there was an error in that listing. The decimals were incorrectly placed and an assessment rate for public opt-out was indicated where no such assessment exists. The decimal placement cause the rate to listed too high by a factor of 10. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused. Below is the corrected assessment rates for self-insured entities.
