CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 2230

To All Members and Subscribers of the WCRIBMA:

Rate Filing, Pending Premium Change Endorsement

The WCRIBMA submitted a rate filing today to the Division of Insurance on behalf of its members recommending a 7.7% increase in average rates for industrial classes and a 13.4% decrease for F-Classes. The WCRIBMA filed no change to expense constants.

The proposed effective date of this filing is January 1, 2014. The Commissioner of Insurance will issue a hearing notice soon and we will then issue another Circular Letter attaching a copy of that notice. We will also post additional information as it becomes available on our website at www.wcribma.org.

In anticipation of the Rate Filing, the WCRIBMA has been issuing ratings effective on January 1, 2014 and subsequent with a preliminary status. At the conclusion of the rate case, the WCRIBMA will revise the preliminary ratings.

Until a decision is received, carriers should attach the Massachusetts Pending Premium Change Endorsement (WC 20 04 01) to all new and renewal policies effective on or after January 1, 2014. A copy of that endorsement is attached for your convenience.
