CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 2260

To Members and Subscribers of the WCRIBMA:

POLICY DATA QUALITY INCENTIVE PROGRAM (PDQIP)

Finable data quality edits that were included in Circular Letter 2250 will be tracked for policy transactions received July 1, 2015 and later, for policies effective July 1, 2015 and later. Error reports in Manage Policy will display additional columns to allow carriers to track the finable edit errors.

Invoices for PDQIP fines will be distributed to carriers monthly; however, there will be an amnesty period for the first 6 months. The August 2015 invoice (for fines accrued in July 2015) through the January 2016 invoice (for fines accrued in December 2015) will be informational only and not subject to collection. Invoices produced February 2016 and forward will be subject to collection.

The Manage Policy Error Reports screen will display additional columns to allow carriers to search for and track finable errors. The 'Is Finable' column on the Error Reports will only display 'Y' if the edit is finable and the error is unresolved. If the error has been resolved, it will no longer display 'Y'. Similarly, the 'First Fine Date' column on the Error Reports will only show a date if the edit is finable and the error is unresolved.

The PDQIP outlines that carriers will be notified at least 6 months in advance of any data quality edit becoming finable. All changes to finable data quality edits will be introduced either January 1 or July 1. Attached is the list of data quality edits that may be finable for transactions received January 1, 2016 and later.
