## CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 2355

To All Members and Subscribers of the WCRIBMA:

## ADJUSTED INDIVIDUAL PAYROLL LIMITATIONS

### EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2019 APPLICABLE TO NEW AND RENEWAL BUSINESS

The individual weekly payroll limitations for executive officer minimum and maximum and Code 9186 – "Carnival, Circus or Amusement Device Operations –Traveling - All Employees & Drivers maximum, and Codes 9178 – "Athletic Team or Park: Non-Contact Sports and 9179 - "Athletic Team or Park: Contact Sports maximum are revised annually to reflect the observed percentage change in the SAWW over the previous year's SAWW.

# The executive officer minimum and maximum individual weekly payroll limitations are calculated as follows:

Step 1: Initial Value = UMAXnew = UMAXold\* x (SAWWnew / SAWWold) UMAXnew = \$1,101.03 x (\$1,431.66/\$1,383.41) = \$1,139.43

Step 2: Initial Value = UMINnew = UMINold\* x (SAWWnew / SAWWold) UMINnew = \$220.21 x (\$1,431.66/\$1,383.41) = \$227.89

Step 3: Basis of Premium equals the Initial Value rounded to the nearest \$10. MAXnew = \$1,139.43 rounds to \$1,140. MINnew = \$227.89 rounds to \$230

# The maximum individual weekly payroll limitations for Codes 9186, 9178, and 9179 are calculated as follows:

Step 1: Initial Value = CMAXnew = CMAXold\* x (SAWWnew / SAWWold) CMAXnew = \$330.32 x (\$1,431.66/\$1,383.41) = \$341.84

Step 2: Basis of Premium equals the Initial Value rounded to the nearest \$10. CMAX new = \$341.84 rounds to \$340

<sup>\*</sup> The values used for UMAXold, UMINold and CMAXold are last year's unrounded figures.

Effective October 1, 2019, the SAWW in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts increased to \$1,431.66 from \$1,383.41. Consequently, the following individual payroll limitations outlined above are:

Executive Officer, Elected Official or Spouse Weekly Minimum Executive Office, Elected Official or Spouse Weekly Maximum Maximum average weekly wage for Codes 9186, 9178 and 9179	\$230

This change only effects new and renewal business effective on or after October 1, 2019.
